## U.S. Department of State Information

- For individuals in Israel, fill out the U.S. State Department's *crisis intake form*, which is the best method for reaching the Department and getting assistance quickly. The form may also be filled out on behalf of individuals.
- Fill out the form only once. If there are any changes in circumstances after initial crisis intake, respond to the provided email.
