- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Hazardous Workplace
- 5 Accountability Act of 2024".
- 6 SEC. 2. LABEL AND WARNING LANGUAGES.
- 7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 6(b)(7) of the Occupa-
- 8 tional Safety and Health Act of 1970 (29 U.S.C.

- 1 655(b)(7)) is amended by inserting after the first sentence
- 2 the following: "Such standard shall prescribe that any
- 3 safety data sheets required as part of a label or other form
- 4 of warning be produced in both English and Spanish by
- 5 the chemical manufacturer or importer and provided to
- 6 employers, and that such safety data sheets are made ac-
- 7 cessible to employees exposed to the hazard.".
