

**Rep. Cuellar Secures Language and Funding in Appropriations Bills to Support DHS  
Unified Headquarters in Laredo**

**FY19 Homeland Security Appropriations Report:** "As directed by House Report 115-948, the Department shall assess the feasibility of establishing a unified headquarters for U.S. Customs and Border Protection and U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement operational components in South Texas."

**FY20 Homeland Security Appropriations Report:** "Unified Headquarters in South Texas.—The Committee reminds DHS of the directive in House Report 116–9 to assess the feasibility of establishing a unified headquarters for CBP and ICE operational components in the South Texas region, and looks forward to receiving information on the results of that assessment."

**FY21 Homeland Security Appropriations Bill:** \$27,400,000 for a new Air and Marine Operations (AMO) hangar facility in Laredo.
